This single-vineyard, 2011 Shenandoah Valley Syrah is medium bodied, supple, and immediately drinkable. The 2011 vintage is rich in black cherries, red currants, and spice flavors offering a complexity that develops nicely in the glass. With a combination of firm tannins and brilliant acidity, this wine is enjoyable now.
